Also, **include products and accessories** to use with your drinks **at your party**. Always remember to drink in moderation and responsibility to avoid accidents. Pass the key!

Here's some information on some of E. Guigal and Juvé & Camps's favorites .

1. E. Guigal Côtes du Rhône Rouge 2017



Guigal Côtes du Rhône Rouge offers tremendous warmth, taste and pleasure, but in a decidedly individual way. It is, unlike virtually all the other Côtes du Rhône, based on Syrah, a northern Rhône approach that **lends greater aromatic intensity and structure**, although it is much more difficult and expensive to produce in the southern Rhône.

This deep, dark red is intensely aromatic on the nose with black fruit and spices. In general, a complete wine, with a long finish, with elegance and finesse accompanying the abundance of fruit and balanced tannins.

2. Château de Nalys Châteauneuf-du-Pape Grand Vin 2017



The realization of the dream of the Guigal family of Châteauneuf-du-Pape: three extraordinary vineyards that come together in one intensely expressive and absolutely complete wine. The Grand Vin defines the style of the estate with a precision of fruits, spices and minerality and, in particular, a beautifully composed structure that unfolds and builds.

This wine is deep and dark, with an intense nose of red and black fruits and spices . A beautiful composition, with silky tannins, power and elegance. Accompany red meats grilled or cooked in sauces, game birds or cured cheeses.

## 3. Juvé & Camps Reserva de la Familia Gran Reserva 2017



A winemaking family for more than 200 years, Juvé began producing sparkling wines under his name in 1921. This 100% estate-based family producer is revered in Spain for his meticulous focus on quality and sustainability.

'Reserva de la Familia' is the world's leading Grand Reserve, always with a vintage date, and all the more it stands out for the quality necessary to produce it without dosing ('Brut Nature' denomination). **Deep, intense and elegant, it initially evokes notes of ripe white fruits followed by hints of fennel, toast and citrus** to complete its distinguished aroma. Its creamy mousse blends in perfectly on the palate, making its texture in the mouth fresh, rounded and suggestive at the same time.

## 4. Juvé & Camps Gran Reserva 2015



Since its first production in 1972, Gran Juvé has always been an emblematic Cava, representing the best of Juvé & Camps. Categorized as "Brut" with only 5g / I dosage, it is only produced in exceptional vintages and is made with grapes of the best quality from selected plots of vineyards.

Aged in the bottle for about 42 months, it shows the intensity and complexity that Cava can achieve. **Notes of white flowers and stone fruit are followed by long aging cava notes: brioche, toast, spices and honey**. Chardonnay contributes to the creamy mouthfeel and Xarel·lo to the elegance and long finish. Exquisitely balanced, this dry cava is expressive, intense, complex and fresh, a harmony of infinite sensations.
