The fruit for this wine is grown in selected old vineyards with excellent south-east exposure, where growers have reduced their yields considerably to produce excellent quality fruit. On the palate, it is rich and well-balanced, with a refreshing finish.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 100% Pinot Grigio

VINEYARD: The vineyards are located between 100-300 meters above sea level in the hills of the Alpone valley, in the commune of Monteforte d'Alpone in eastern Soave. The fruit for this wine is grown in selected old vineyards with ...

VINTAGE: 2022 was a dry and warm vintage overall. The grapes were healthy, with no disease pressure or issues across the vintage. Given this, harvest saw great quality grapes...

FERMENTATION: Hand harvesting, temperature controlled fermentation in stainless steel

AGING: Stainless steel for several months
