Crafted in the traditional Charmat method, Alpha Zeta's Prosecco takes advantage of some notably cool sites to produce and exceedingly fresh style of wine. Notes of pear and white flower permeate the wine, with a notably fine mousse and refreshing finish.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 100% Glera

VINEYARD: The vineyards are located in the hills and are north facing. The hillside sites experience cooler nights, allowing the aromatic compounds of the grapes to develop. The vines are trained using the Guyot system. The soil i...

FERMENTATION: Hand harvested grapes, temperature controlled fermentation, Charmat method production
