Located on the right bank of the Rhône river, this unique collective of growers fosters international varieties on a mix of soils and elevations. While most cooperatives pay out on volume, here the farmers are paid for quality, allowing ideal ripening times and responsible vineyard management.

THE WINE

Vignerons Ardéchois' Chardonnay does a remarkable balancing act between bright citrus and green apple notes and a delicately buttery texture. The wine's versatile flavor profile appeals to a broad range of Chardonnay and white wine drinkers alike.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 100% Chardonnay

VINEYARD: Most of the Chardonnay comes from between Valvignères and Vogüé, in the North of the Ardèche growing region. Soils are mostly composed of chalky-clay soils, vineyards are 400-500 meters above sea level....

FARMING: HVE Certified, Practicing Organic

CERTIFICATIONS: HVE Certified (EU)

FERMENTATION: Picked and pressed in the early morning to preserve freshness

AGING: 3-4 months on the lees in stainless steel, 50% of malolactic fermentation blocked
