### ABOUT VIGNERONS ARDÉCHOIS

Since 1967, Vignerons Ardéchois has embodied the excellence of winemaking in Ardèche. Located on the right bank of the Rhône river, this unique collective of growers fosters international varieties on a mix of soils and elevations. While most cooperatives pay out on volume, here the farmers are paid for quality, allowing ideal ripening times and responsible vineyard management.

### THE WINE

The Pinot Noir is a joyful expression of the variety, grown on naturally low-yielding soils that focus the flavors of the final wine. Simple fermentation methods allow the mix of soil types to shine, while the high altitude sites build a refreshing acidity.

### TECHNICAL INFORMATION

**VARIETY:** 100% Pinot Noir

**VINEYARD:** Clay and limestone soils from around the town of Alba la Romaine form the backbone of this wine. 70ha of vineyards form this wine, planted on clay/limestone and volcanic soils at 400-500 meters above sea level...

**FARMING:** HVE Certified, Practicing Organic

**CERTIFICATIONS:** HVE Certified (EU)

**FERMENTATION:** Picked and pressed in the early morning to preserve freshness

**AGING:** 4-6 months between cement and stainless-steel vats

**ALC. BY VOL.:** 13%
