ABOUT TENUTE BOSCO

Tenute Bosco's vision is dedicated to Mount Etna. Inspired by the natural beauty and respect for this terroir, winemaker Sofia Ponzini finds a perfect balance between ancient traditions and modern technology. Featuring a white, rosato and two reds, the wines have found quick international acclaim for their simultaneously ethereal yet focused style.

THE WINE

The Etna Rosso is a careful selection of Nerello Mascalese (90%) and Nerello Cappuccio (10%) from Piano dei Daini, an old contrada in the town of Solicchiata. The palate expresses harmonious layers of fresh cherries, dewy earth and salted licorice, with a typically-Etna backbone of invigorating minerality.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 90% Nerello Mascalese, 10% Nerello Cappuccio

VINEYARD: The vineyard, Vigne Curve, grows at an altitude of 600 meters above sea level, where wine has been produced since 1670. The vines are trained in the Espalier system, involving multiple cordons set along the same trellis...

FARMING: Organic

CERTIFICATIONS: Organic

FERMENTATION: Destemming and soft crushing of the grapes; racking via gravity into steel vats for a 15 day, temperature controlled fermentation over 15 days. Daily punch-downs.

AGING: After malolactic fermentation, the wine ages in 700 liter French Tonneau for 10 – 12 months, three months in steel vats and a minimum of 6 months in the bottle.
