ABOUT TENUTE BOSCO

Tenute Bosco's vision is dedicated to Mount Etna. Inspired by the natural beauty and respect for this terroir, winemaker Sofia Ponzini finds a perfect balance between ancient traditions and modern technology. Featuring a white, rosato and two reds, the wines have found quick international acclaim for their simultaneously ethereal yet focused style.

THE WINE

Vico expresses all of its potential from a unique and ancient terroir on Mt Etna, being sourced. It comes from one of the very few parcels in the contrada Santo Spirito that were not covered by the lava flow of 1879.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 90% Nerello Mascalese, 10% Nerello Cappuccio

VINEYARD: Vigna Vico is a bush vine trained site featuring pre-phyloxera vines located in the town of Passopisciaro, Contrada Santo Spirito. The growing area sits 700m above sea level, and features sandy volcanic soils...

FARMING: Organic

CERTIFICATIONS: Organic

FERMENTATION: The juice undergoes a fast maceration with the skins before temperature controlled fermentation for 10 days.

AGING: After malolactic fermentation the wine ages in 700 liter French Tonneau for at least 14 months, then in steel vats for at least 1 month and about 20 months in the bottle.

ALC. BY VOL.: 13%
