THE WINE

The IGT Ridolfo is a surprisingly magical union of Cabernet Sauvignon (50%) and Pugnitello (50%). This wine perfectly integrates internationality and tradition and offers another interpretation of the splendid terroir of Monti in Chianti, within Chianti Classico. It is exclusively bottled in Magnums and Jeroboams, with hand numbered bottles.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 50% Pugnitello

VINEYARD: Geologically, the territory of Monti in Chianti is mainly composed of limestone and marlstone that are rich in calcium (Marna Calcareo) and contain a certain amount of clays. Harvest is manual and carried out in three ph...

FARMING: Organic

AGING: 25 months between Alliers 57% barrique and 43% tonneaux, 10% first pass, 30% second pass, 60% third pass, 36 months in bottle
