ABOUT DOMAINE HUBERT BROCHARD

Since its creation in 1900, Hubert Brochard has been committed to producing wines representative of the diversity of the Sancerre terroirs. It is this richness of the land, the plurality of styles and personalities, the meeting of cultures and know-how that allows one to (re)discover the subtleties of this appellation. The Brochard team is led by esteemed winemaker Rodrigo Zamorano with a precise target: to showcase the unique individuality of Sancerre Terroirs.

THE WINE

This Sauvignon comes mostly from vineyards in seven villages, with the three famous Sancerre Terroirs: Chalk, flint, Caillotes. Sauvignon grapes are harvested partly by machine and partly by hand. Pressing is only in pneumatic presses. Vinification takes place in stainless steel tanks with controlled temperature in order to keep all the fine aromas of Sauvignon. A perfect expression of an ideal Sancerre.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

VINEYARD: Hubert Brochard is a total of 93 Ha in Sancerre region. It is very fragmented on 8 villages. Powerful erosion has developed many types of soils (Chalk, Caillotes and flint).

WINE MAKING: Chilean-born winemaker Rodrigo Zamorano has a true passion for Sauvignon Blanc. In order to express all the aromas but also the elegance and the purity of this grape, Rodrigo

VINTAGE: A warm, dry summer in the Central Loire with timely September rain in 2023 resulted in grapes reaching full ripeness and textbook alcohol levels.

AGING: Six months in stainless steel tanks, no oak
