E. Guigal Côtes du Rhône Rosé, \$19

This Côtes du Rhône Rosé exudes clarity and brilliance, with a fresh and expressive nose reveals red fruits and citrus notes, including raspberry and redcurrant. It's a very well balanced rosé that your father will appreciate.



Juvé & Camps Pinot Noir Rosé NV, \$25

From the heart of Spain's Penedès region, Juvé & Camps Pinot Noir Rosé NV is a sparkling Cava made with 100 percent Pinot Noir grapes. Crisp and refreshing, it offers fine bubbles and notes of rose petal, red currant, and wild raspberry. It's actually a delicious pairing with potato chips so open up a bottle with your dad and watch his favorite movie or sports game with it.



Château d'Estoublon Roseblood Rosé, \$27

Just a year ago, Château d'Estoublon's Roseblood Rosé has made its debut in the U.S. market. This exquisite rosé boasts a stunning pale and delicate hue of rose water. Its expressive aroma reveals notes of apricot and peony, with just the right touch of minerality. It's a great wine to sip with your dad.
