ABOUT DOMAINE CHANSON

Chanson is a true mid-size Domaine. Unlike many of their competitors, their wines are produced using the grower model rather than the négociant model. They have extensive holdings of over 111 acres of exclusively Premier and Grand Cru vineyards in the heart of Burgundy. Chanson is obsessed with maintaining a consistent quality level across the entire range. The wines have a seductive and distinctive style due to the rigorous approach to viticulture and vinification.

THE WINE

Domaine Chanson Beaune Premier Cru Bressandes is sourced from a 1.1-acre vineyard located on the upper slopes of Beaune, facing east at the mouth of a cool, north-facing valley. Named after Jean Bressand, a 13th-century Canon of Beaune, this vineyard produces some of the village's most respected wines. The wine presents a brilliant ruby color with intense aromas of raspberry and cherry, complemented by subtle hints of spice and vanilla. On the palate, it offers a dense, deep texture with beautiful tension, elegant tannins, and a long, fruit-driven finish.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VARIETY: 100% Pinot Noir

VINEYARD: From a 1.1 hectare, eastern-facing vineyard on limestone soils on the upper part of the hill in Beaune.

WINEMAKING: Hand-picked in small crates, followed by meticulous sorting. Whole bunch pressing. Fermentation in barrel at low temperature for 15 to 20 days.

VINTAGE: The 2022 Burgundy vintage saw heat and drought, but well-timed rains preserved balance. Early harvest yielded ripe, fresh wines with good quality in both reds and whites.

AGING: Aged 20 months on fine lees in French oak barrels (20% new, 1 to 6 years old, 228L) and 10% in WineGlobe in a 15th-century Bastion
