### ABOUT PONZI VINEYARDS

For over 50 years, Ponzi Vineyards has had the honor of being Oregon wine country's most influential pioneer and contemporary standard bearer. Old vines, organic viticulture, and an uncompromising dedication to excellence distinguish Ponzi as the premier winery in Oregon.

### THE WINE

Ponzi's Pinot Noir Reserve is made exclusively from estate fruit, including some of Oregon's oldest vines. For over 50 years, the Ponzi family has farmed 140 acres of certified sustainable vineyards on Laurelwood soils. Over time, the vines have evolved, with red fruit in their youth giving way to dark berry and brambly spice. The Reserve's layered complexity make it one of the finest examples of site-expressive Pinot Noir in North America. As Wine Spectator once wrote, "All Oregon Pinot Noirs are measured against the Ponzi yardstick."

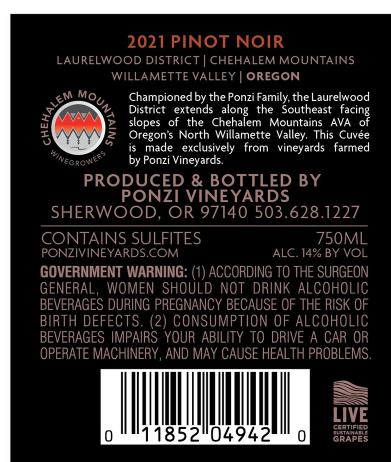
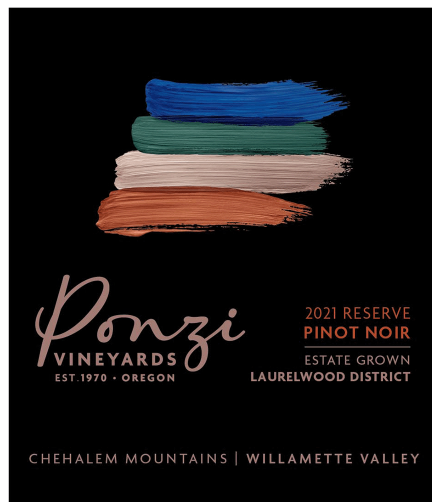
